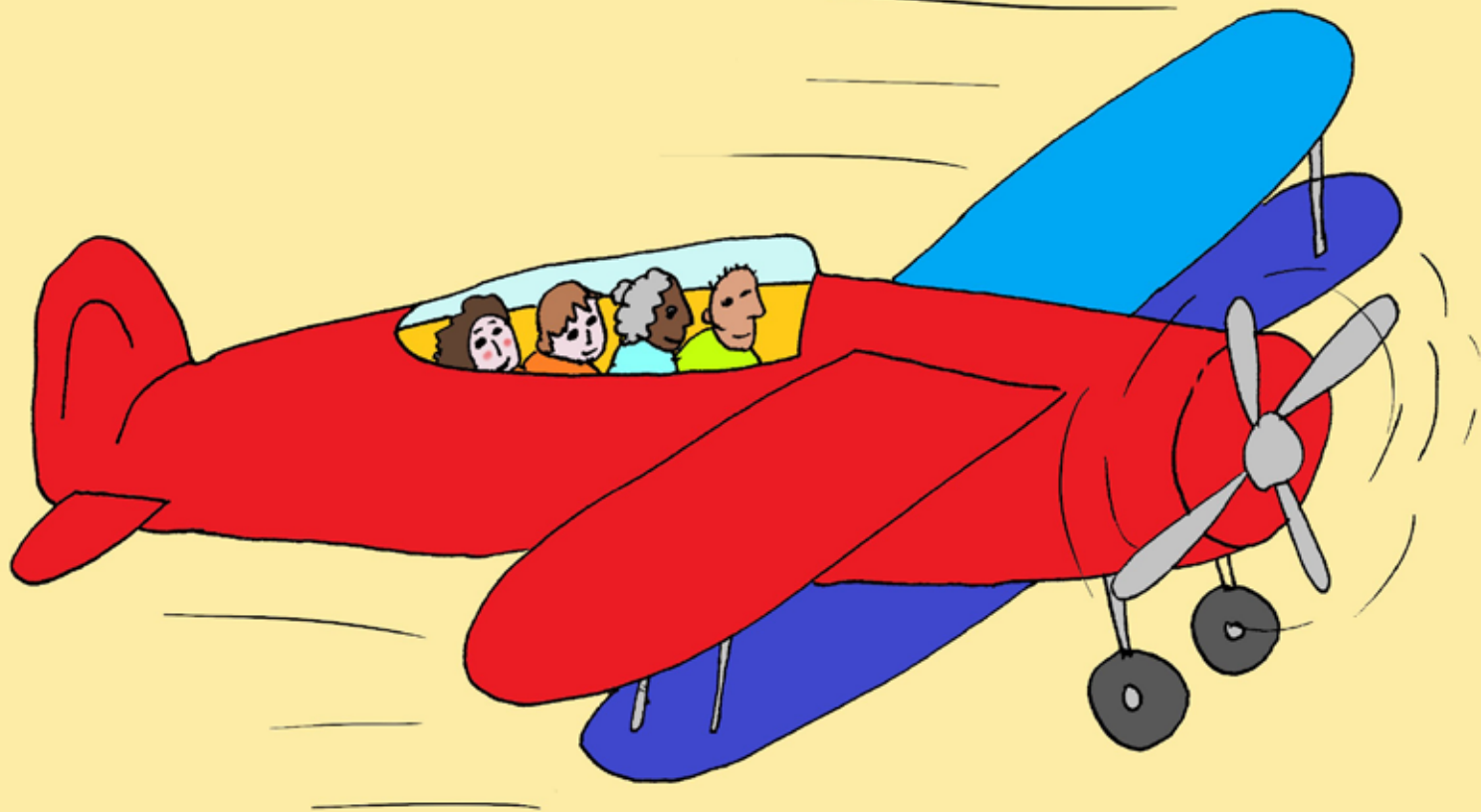

First we visited the Forum Romanum, a part of ancient Rome with crumbling ruins, columns and pillars. Next off to the Coliseum!



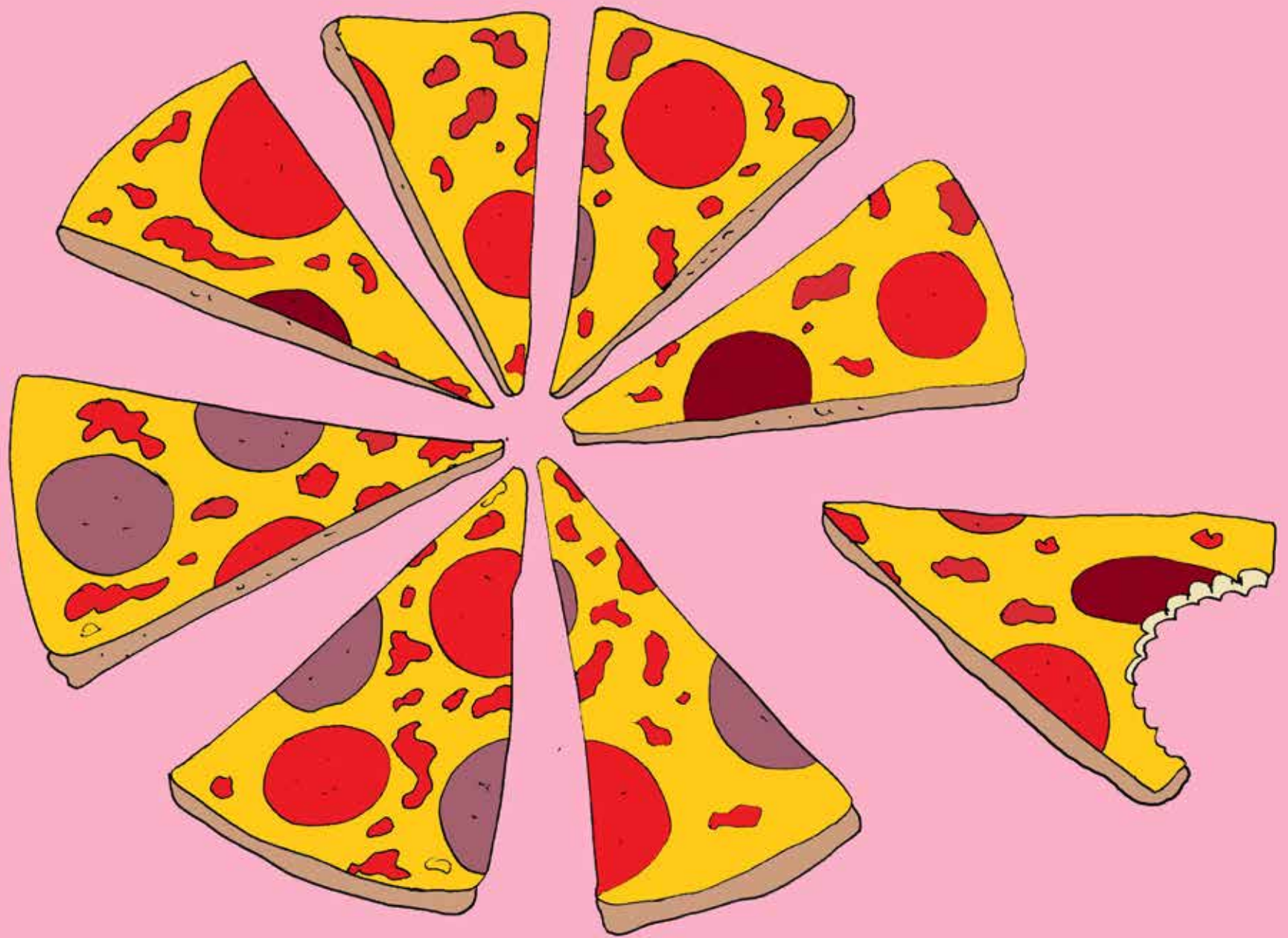
We grabbed ice creams on our way.

like tiny ants or spiders.

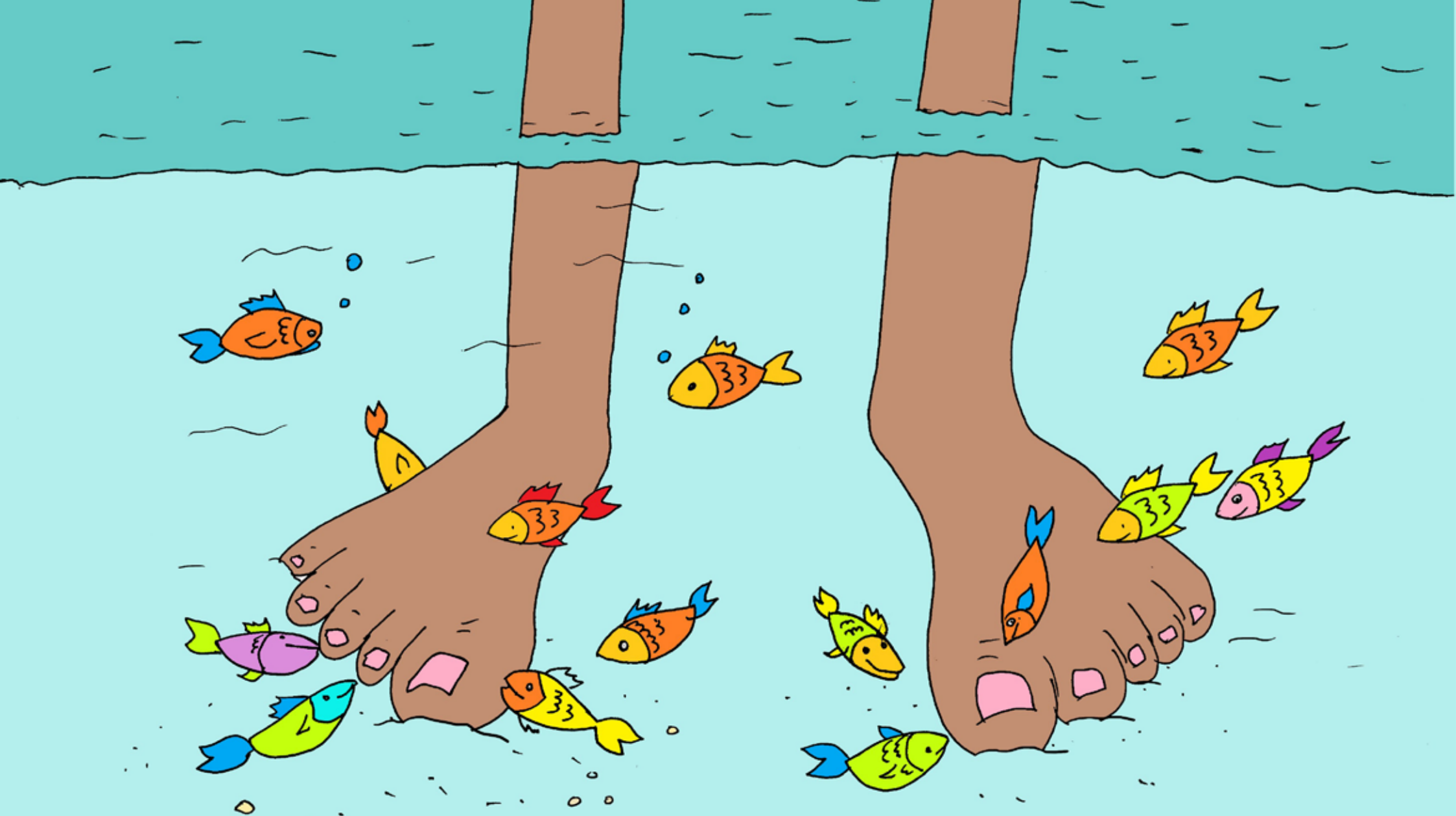




Afterwards we got pizzas - Pizza Mozzarella, Gino's favourite.
