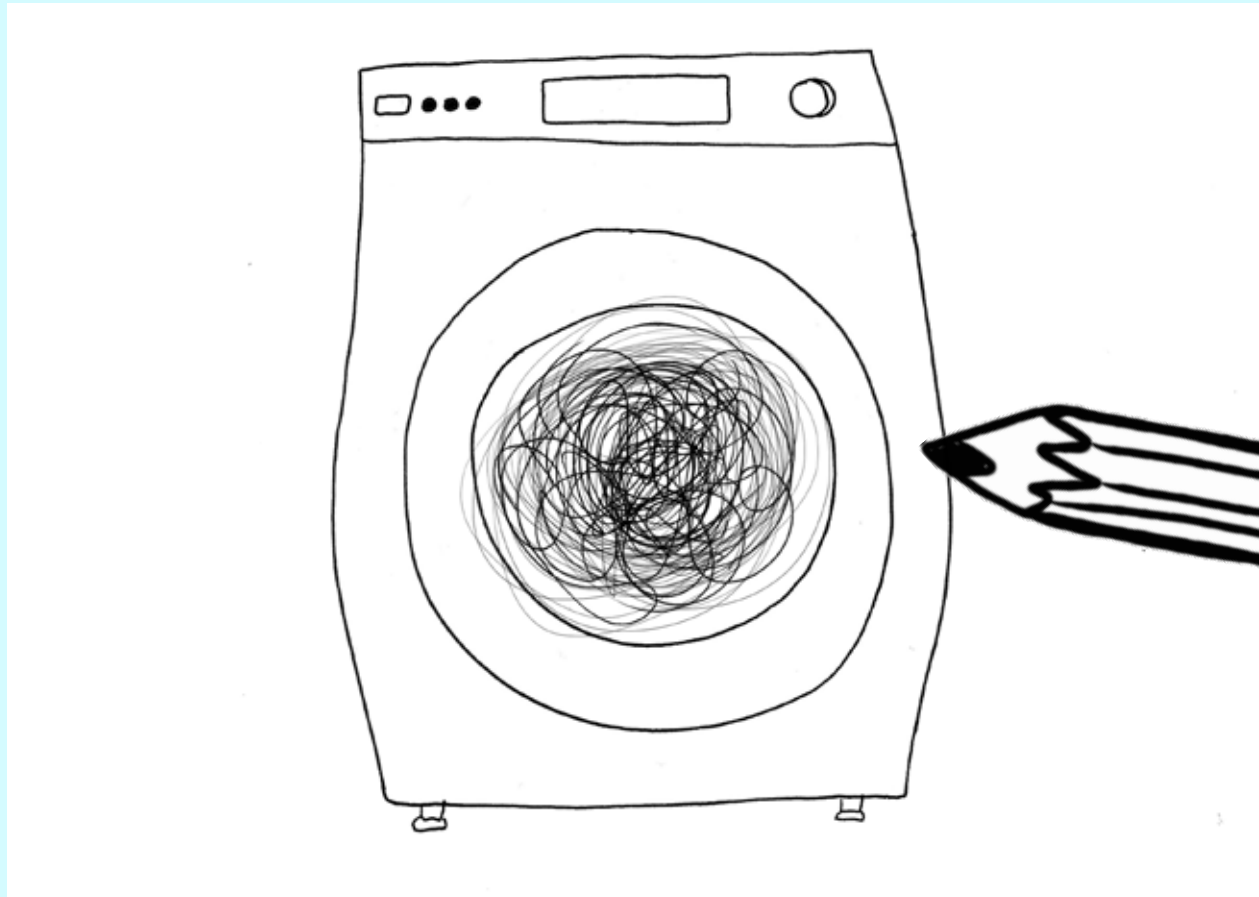

I'm washing Lulu's things.

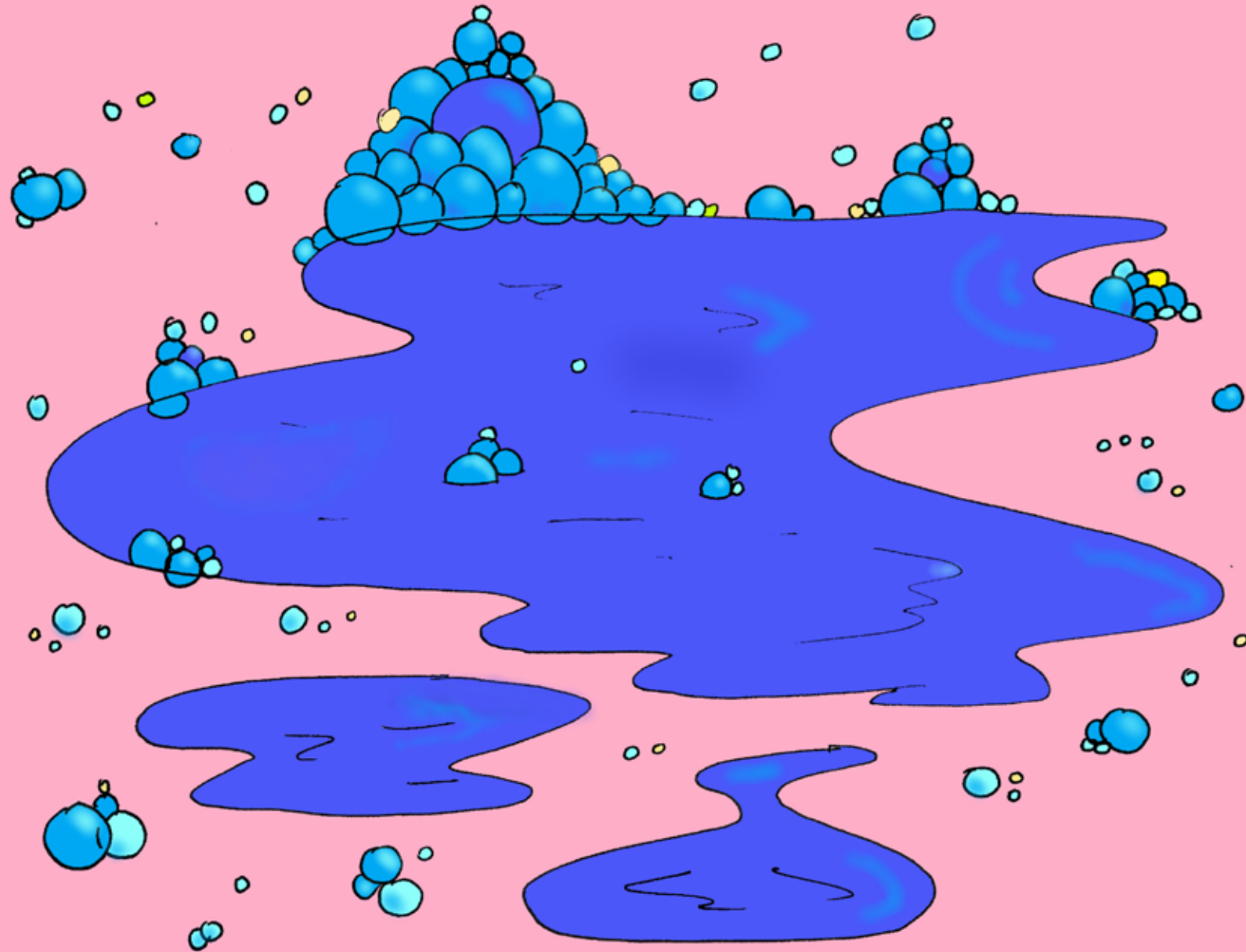
In my drum there are red jumpers and bubbles, one odd sock,

My door came open and water spilled all over the floor.



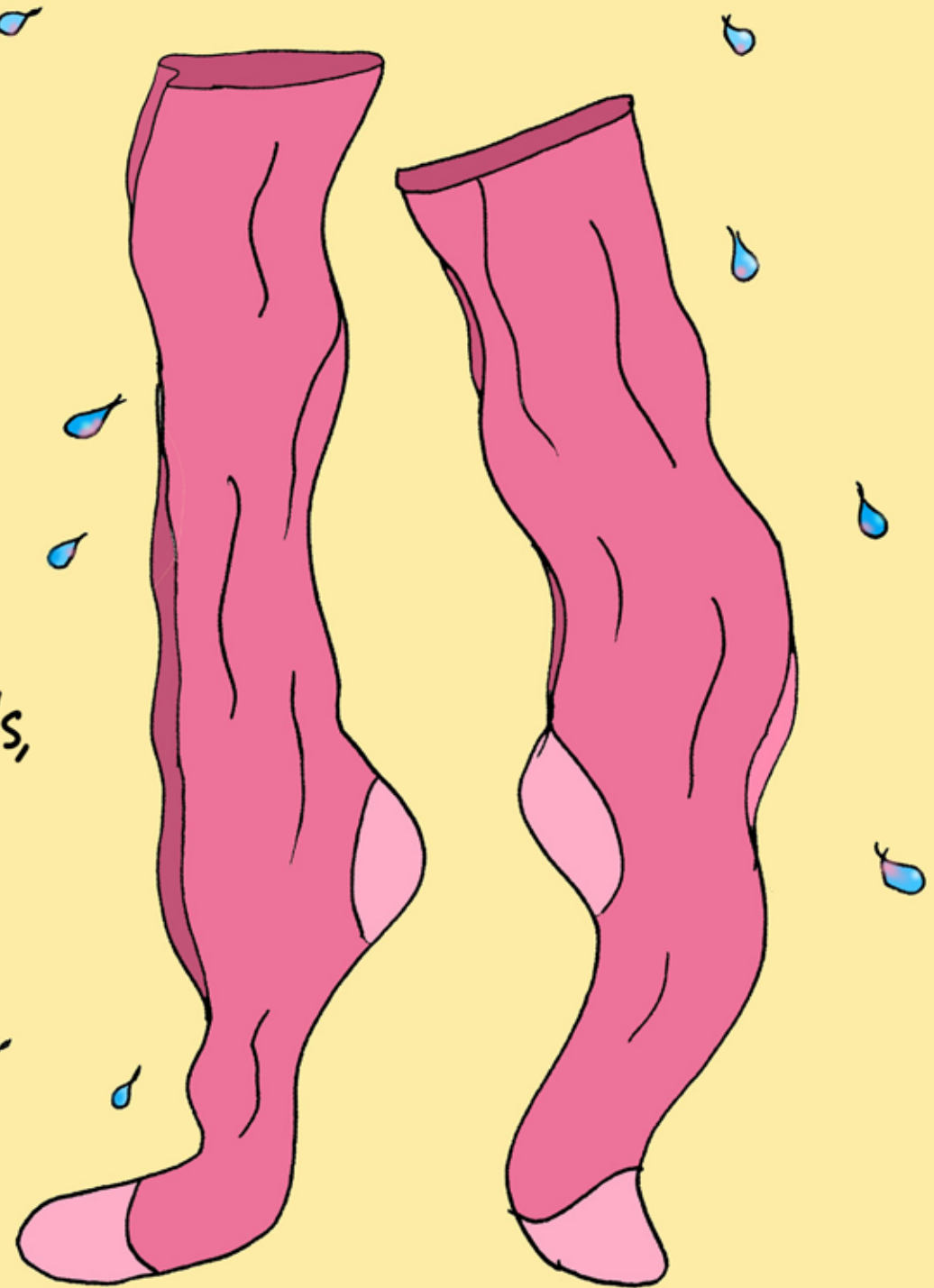
I jumped across the room, heading for the grey washing basket,

spinning and shaking.

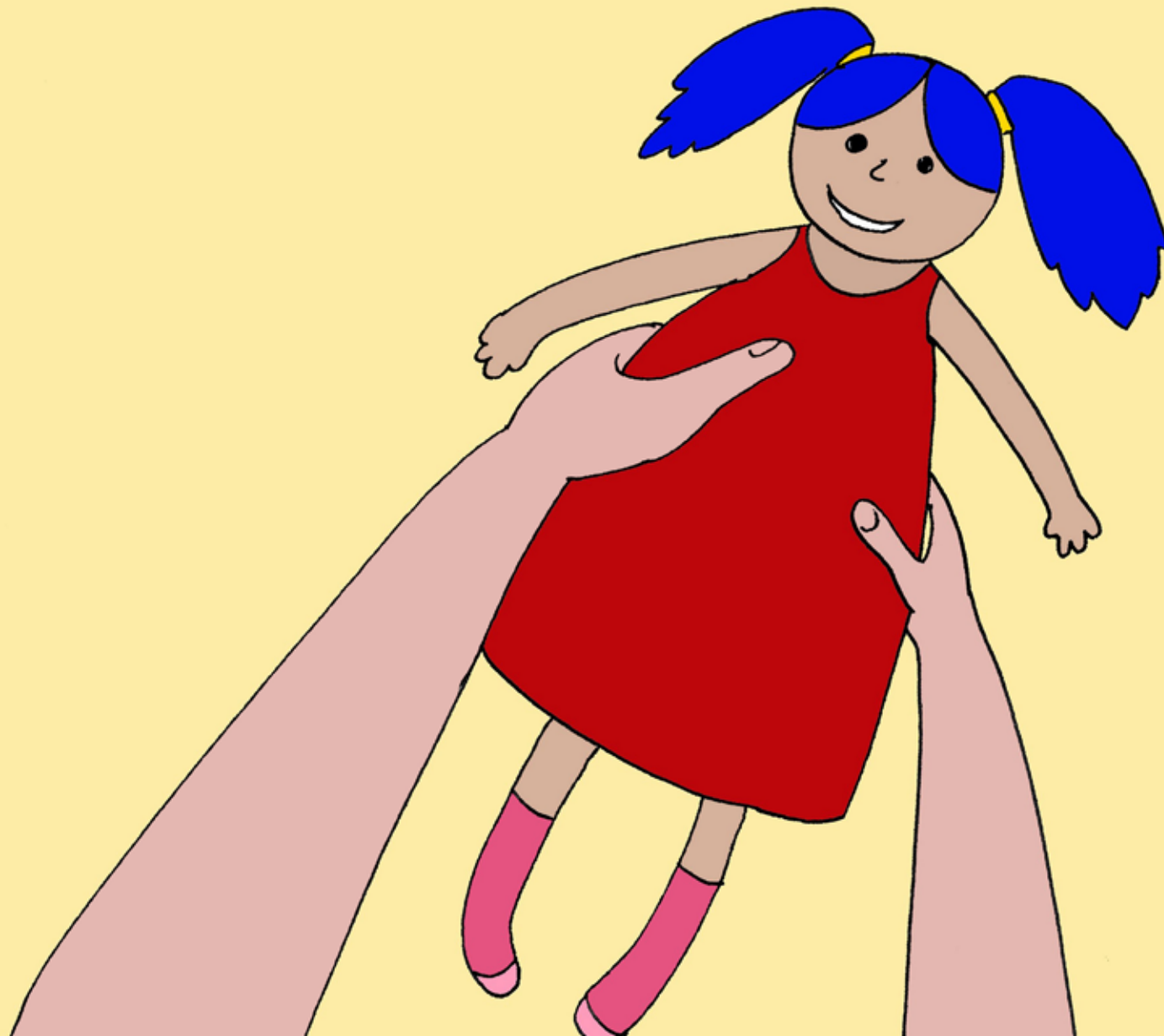




The pink socks belong to Looby Lou who is having fun chasing them in my dryer drum to put them on.
